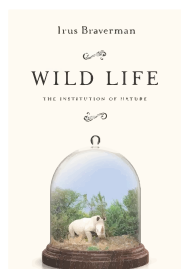

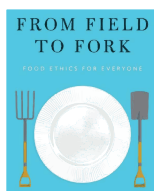

Wild Life documents a nuanced understanding of the wild versus captive divide in species conservation. Providing a unique window into the high-stakes world of nature conservation, Irus Braverman describes the heroic efforts by conservationists to save wild life.

Girl in the Woods is Aspen Matis's exhilarating true-life adventure of hiking from Mexico to Canada—a coming of age story, a survival story, and a triumphant story of overcoming emotional devastation after being raped by a fellow student.



Thompson shows how food production and consumption are linked to ethical issues regarding social justice and the environment. He constructs a map of the field that brings together often disconnected discussions concerning poverty, obesity, animal welfare, environmental protection and gene technology.
